

Nursery Tip of the Week



Spruce It Up
Spruce Up Your Annual Flower Beds - with some warm season annuals like Begonias, Geraniums, Impatiens, Celosia and Zinnias. Remove faded flowers to encourage continuous blooming and fertilize with a slow-release granular fertilizer like Bradfield Organics All-Purpose Fertilizer. Or, for instant results, use a liquid fertilizer like Hast Gro or Garrett Juice. Liquid Fish will also act as a fertilizer while also repelling insects.

Weed Control
Warmer Weather Brings Weeds With It - 20% Vinegar is a kid-safe, pet-safe, organic option to control weeds. Vinegar is a non-selective herbicide so only spray it on the weeds you'd like to get rid of and adding 1 tbsp. of orange oil will help the vinegar to stick to the weeds for more effective control. Blackjack 21 is also available which already has the orange oil mixed in. 2-4-D Amine and HiYield Weed & Feed are non-organic options that can also be used on broadleaf weeds. And remember, if spraying or applying a granule is not an option, just pull 'em!
