



Nursery Tip of the Week

Prune
Prune Roses - Bush roses should be pruned back by 50%. Remove all weak, non-productive canes and prune remaining strong canes back by half. Cut just above buds that face away from the center of the plant using sharp shears and cutting at a slight angle.

Prune Fruit Trees - After pruning apply Fertilome Pruning Sealer or Pruning Paint to help facilitate quicker healing and to help keep insects out.

Plant Potatoes - If you are cutting the potatoes before planting, coat the pieces with sulfur and let them callous.

Plant Onions - Harvest green onions as bulbs begin to enlarge and plants become crowded. Larger onions should be harvested in late spring, once 2/3 of the tops have died to the ground (generally 2-3 months after planting).
