

Nursery Tip of the Week



Harvest
Harvest Cool Season Herbs and Leafy Vegetables - When harvesting leafy vegetables, harvest the lower leaves first. Harvest broccoli when the largest flower buds in the head are the size of the head of a match. When harvesting herbs be careful not to deplete all the plant's foliage. Take no more than 1/3 of the total foliage at any one time. Herbs will look best and are more compact in size when harvested regularly.

Water
Keep Vegetable Gardens Watered - It is best to use soaker hoses or sprinklers when watering vegetable gardens to ensure deep, thorough watering. Vegetable gardens usually need 1-2 inches of water per week.

Sod
Time To Lay Sod - When laying sod it is best to apply a layer of top soil first and then water well after laying your sod. Shortly after laying you can fertilize using any of our Organic Fertilizers.
