Fertilize Roses

Fertilize Roses - using a long-lasting slow release granular fertilizer like Nature's Guide Rose Food. Spread 1/4 to 1/2 cup around the base of the bush and water it in.

Water Roses

Water Roses - roses need 1-1.5 inches of water a week. When watering avoid wetting the foliage and maintain consistent soil moisture during the growing season.

Control Diseases

Maintain a regular disease control schedule - also, keep an eye out for insects. Organic Neem oil is an organic insecticide, miticide and fungicide that is safe to use on roses in addition to vegetables, fruits, nuts and flowers. If you are seeing fungus on your crepe myrtles, use the Neem Oil topically or RosePride Funginex which works systemically.
