

# Nursery Tip of the Week



*Fertilize Vegetables*

**Now Is The Perfect Time To Sidedress Vegetables Planted In March** - use an Organic Fertilizer like Texas Tee 6-2-4, Bluebonnet 6-2-4 or Nature's Guide Tomato & Pepper Food to help yield a better crop. Fertilize tomatoes, peppers and squash when they set their first fruit and cucumbers, cantaloupe and watermelon should be fertilized when they begin to run.

*Water Vegetables*

**Vegetable Gardens Need 1-2 Inches Of Water Each Week** - soaker hoses work best to keep the water off the foliage. Keep in mind that spring storm season can bring lots of rain and you may not need to water as much.

*Treat Fungus*

**If Your Roses Or Crepe Myrtles Start Showing Signs Of Fungus** - treat the whole bush or tree with an organic fungicide like garlic spray, potassium bicarbonate, or Neem oil which is also an insecticide and miticide.
